Now that the holiday cooking is over, its time to get back to good old basic southern food. Maybe some of you ladies would like to fix this for the next covered dish dinner. (Sorry, I do not recall who sent it to me)

Hawg Brain-n-Sardine Casserole (*Rowan County, Southern*)

2 lb. fresh hawg brains (undrained)

2 cans sardines (undrained)

2 c. stale hard biscuits (crumbled)

1 (16 oz.) pkg. egg noodles

6 eggs beaten

1 bottle Louisiana hot sauce

Get a great 0l' big bowl and dump your brains in, juice and all. Then throw in all the sardines and don't waste that juice either cause it's finger-lickin' good. Add the beaten eggs and mix well. Then pour in the bottle of hot sauce and mix well. Next fold in the stale biscuit crumbs. Layer this mixture with alternate layers of egg noodles starting with the noodles first. Then bake in a preheated 375 degree oven for 1 1/2 hours or until the Haz-Mat truck arrives. Enjoy!

This is my favorite dish because: *The way those brains and egg noodles looks all throwed together and the unique aroma that the sardines lends to it all just makes my big '0l mouth water every time.*
